You came to the Cradle on February 7th, 1974 and signed the legal documents necessary for your daughter's adoption.

A Cradle Caseworker met with your daughter and her adoptive parents at The Cradle in May 1974. Her adoptive parents reported she was fairly easy to care for, ate well, and slept well except for a few nights. At that time, your daughter weighed 18 pounds and measured 26½ inches long. She had had one inoculation.

A Cradle caseworker met with your daughter and her adoptive family in their home in July, 1974. Your daughter weighed 20 lbs and measured 28 inches. She had brown eyes and brown hair. There were no illnesses to date and her inoculations were up to date. No problems were reported with her hearing and vision. She sat up at 4½ months and turned over at 5 months. She was beginning to crawl. She had two teeth. Your daughter was alert and interacted well with other people. Her older sister enjoyed playing with her. Her adoptive parents reported that she eats, sleeps, and plays well.
